Including Handel *Zadok the Priest* and *Hallelujah* from *Messiah*, and Parry *Blest Pair of Sirens*. A lively programme of familiar and rousing choral anthems by Handel and Parry, featuring the Exon Festival Chorus, commemorating the 700th anniversary of Tavistock Parish Church. The Exon Singers will provide contrast with music by Bruckner and Duruflé's *4 motets*. The combined forces will perform Composer-in-Residence Russell Pascoe's new work, to a libretto by Anthony Pinching, *The St Eustachius Triptych*.
